

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- This is a Practice test which is just to create awareness about the Exam interface and the test delivery system. Under no circumstances should this be treated as a sample paper.
- Contents and timing are merely exemplars and actual content will be different on the day of examination.





IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS ABOUT PRACTICE TEST:

1. Only **one** question will be displayed on the computer screen, at a time.
2. This practice test consists of **25** multiple-choice questions (MCQs), each with four options.
3. All questions are **compulsory**.
4. Each question carries **1** mark. There is **NO** negative marking (no penalty for wrong attempt)
5. Total allotted duration for completing the test is **30** minutes.
6. Each question has **four** options. ONLY one option is the correct/best answer. Candidates need to select the **best or most appropriate option**, as answer of each question. In case of any ambiguity, decision of NTA regarding answer key would be final.
7. All tests, except languages are in English only.
8. Use of calculator is NOT permitted, until it is specified.
9. Candidates found copying or resorting to any unfair means (UFM) are liable to be disqualified and their candidature would be cancelled. No plea would be accepted.

Procedure for appearing in Computer Based Test


ABOUT ANSWERING THE QUESTIONS:


1. In order to answer a question, you have to "click" the option you consider is appropriate / correct. The option which has been clicked on will be highlighted and shall be treated as the answer given by you for the question.
2. If you do not wish to attempt the question then you should not click on any option for that question and may click 'Next'.
3. You can 'Bookmark' questions to review before submitting.
4. You can navigate between questions either by clicking on 'Previous'/ 'Next' or by directly clicking on the question numbers which are displayed as attempted/ not-attempted / bookmarked in the Section-wise Summary panel.

5. The questions can be answered in any order in which candidate may wish to do so.
6. The exam screen will continuously display the remaining time at the top right hand corner of the question paper.
7. The candidates may ask the invigilator their doubts or queries before the commencement of test. No queries shall be entertained after the commencement of the examination.

ABOUT THE PREVIEW AND SUBMISSION:

1. The answers are saved whenever the candidate navigates e.g., by clicking on Next/Previous button or by clicking on other question number.
2. The candidates can make changes in their choice of alternative during exam.
3. Candidate can switch to any of the question by clicking on summary panel shown at the left hand side of the screen.
4. After the expiry of **30** minutes the candidates will not be able to attempt any question or check their answers. The answers of the candidate would be saved automatically by the computer system.
5. A "Thank you" message will appear confirming the completion and submission of the examination.
6. Candidates are NOT allowed to leave the examination hall/Centre, when examination is in process, even if they have finished their test.
7. Rough work needs to be done on rough sheet provided to candidates.

OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Candidates can be debarred / disqualified for any of the following reasons during the examination:
 - Attempting to tamper with the operation of the computer or meddling with the system.
 - Exchanging any papers, documents or any other material with other candidates.
 - Leaving the test centre without the permission of the invigilator.
 - Using prohibited (items not allowed) such as any textual material, Calculators, Docu Pen, Slide Rules, Log Tables and Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, printed or written material, bits of papers, mobile phone, Blue-tooth devices, pager or any other electronic gadget/ device etc.
 - Attempting to copy examination questions and /or examination responses (in any format) from the examination centre.
 - Attempting to access any unauthorized software/program during the examination.
 - Failing to follow Invigilators directions.

- Manhandling of Invigilators or test centre staff.
2. Instrument/Geometry/Pencil box, Handbag, Purse or Any kind of Paper/ Stationery, Eatables/snacks and Tea/coffee/cold drinks/Water (loose or packed), Mobile Phone/ Ear Phone/Microphone/Pager, Calculator, Camera, Tape Recorder, any metallic item or electronic gadgets etc. are NOT allowed in the examination Room/Hall.
 3. If any candidate is in possession of any of the above item, his/ her candidature will be treated as unfair means.
 4. Smoking, chewing gutka, spitting etc. in the Examination Room/Hall is strictly prohibited.
 5. Candidates shall maintain silence while appearing for the exam. Any conversation or gesticulating or disturbance or attempt to change seats/question in the Examination Hall shall be deemed as unfair means.
 6. If a candidate is found indulging in unfair means or impersonation, the candidature of such candidate shall be cancelled. Such matter shall also be reported to concerned authorities for appropriate action.
